- .3 the amendments to Rule 13.2.1 (3) of the Student and Related Rules – Posthumous Awards, as detailed in Attachment 2 to Document 8.1, be approved;

Attachment 1 reads:

13.2.1 Coursework

(3) "Where, as a result of death or permanent incapacity, a student ~~fails to complete the assessment requirements for subjects in which the student was enrolled and which if successfully completed, would have satisfied requirements for an award,~~ fails to complete the course requirements, but has completed a substantial proportion of them, the relevant Faculty Board may recommend to Academic Board that the student be deemed to have completed requirements of a course. Such a recommendation would normally be made within two (2) years of the student's last enrolled teaching period and must be supported by relevant documentary evidence."
