

DECISIONS BY THE BOARD OF STUDIES' MEETING JULY 26, 2005

- 1. **Consultation on defining mandatory outcomes in the K-6 curriculum: conclusion and proposals**The Board endorsed the direction taken, namely that stage statements form the appropriate level for organising the Primary curriculum and should be the basis for further work.
- 2. **Assessment rank appeal in HSC English Extension 2, 2004**The Board approved the review panel's recommendation and agreed that the appeal should be declined.
- 3. **Review into allegations of cheating in the HSC**The Board received a tabled paper concerning allegations of HSC candidates being provided with inappropriate assistance in the preparation of HSC school assessment tasks. The Board endorsed the President's action in appointing a review team to prepare a report for the Board, which will form the Board's advice to ICAC.
- 4. **National consistency in curriculum outcomes (NCCO) project**The Board heard a presentation by the Project Director and Phase 2 Project Manager. The Board also received a tabled paper and endorsed the proposed process, at the same time noting the importance of engaging with the business and special education communities as part of the process.
- 5. **Credentialling the School Certificate 2006: final recommendations**The Board approved the approach to credentialing for the School Certificate in 2006, as presented in the various mocked-up documents attached to the Board paper.
- 6. Report on the Trial Computing Skills Test, and directions for the Computing Skills Test from 2006

The Board endorsed the following directions for the 2006 School Certificate Computing Skills test:

- (i) the structure of the test remain as for the 2005 trial test;
- (ii) the time allowed for the test be 75 minutes unless the results of the 2005 trial indicate otherwise;
- (iii) schools be allowed to offer the test in either pen-and-paper or online form;
- (iv) the online test be offered in a flexible delivery format over a number of days following the other School Certificate tests.
- 7. **Submission to the Inquiry into Australia's relationship with the Republic of Korea** The Board approved the submission.
- 8. **Revision of the Assessment, Certification and Examination (ACE) Manual**The Board noted the procedures undertaken for the revision of the 2002 edition of the ACE Manual.
- 9. Interim report on the impact of the Disability Standards for Education on the NSW Board of Studies

The Board noted the information.

10. **Provision of distance education for students outside New South Wales** The Board noted the paper.
